Grade Appeal Assistance

I have been quite busy this month dealing with student grade appeals, spanning across nearly all faculties and nearly all levels of formal appeal process. Since November isn't a time when grade appeals actually occur, I simply explained to students the process of a grade appeal. Many of the appeals were actually not even grade appeals for example some students asked about appealing the GLER requirement. I provided as much information that I could for the students.
