<u>Max</u> - I noticed there is some confusion regarding mailbox ballots.. It seemd to come acaross as a 2nd election process, but it's not it's just an approval of the results. The process is for the election itself, not the individuals. We did converse with our legal counsel to insure that we were following our bylwaw. There were some technical difficulties, but it didn't do anytning to prevent the fairness of the election. There was nothing preventing fairness. This is just a simple ratification and not a 2nd round of elections.

<u>Tyler</u> - Raven is an upstanding student and confident that she will will fulfill duties. <u>Max</u> - If this is something to change in the future then LRC is where we will look and see if there is legislation where we an make special exemptions.

Royal - The LRC is where will make amendments.

<u>Justin</u> - How did this occur? When was the exemption made, and what was the timeline?

Cheri - There is contradictory information.

<u>Jonah</u> - What was the nomination process? Should this individual have been eligible to run for the position?

<u>Max</u> - There was a technical irregularity, and Raven did bring it forward to me. Cheri and I read the special exemption that I brought to the GA, and then it went to the election. As our legal counsel advised us, this would be still considered a fair vote. The vote happened, the information was put forward to the GA. This shouldn't prevent us from going to ratification, to go back on this now would be unethical. I'm confident that Raven will show us she is capable of doing this job, but for now there should not be any reason for this ratification to not occur.

<u>Rachele</u> - I just wanted to ensure the other Arts & Science Reps still feel supported in their roles with Raven as a rep.
