- <u>Rikin</u> this event is open to anyone. On the flip side I agree that we should not be funding the whole amount.
- <u>Rachele</u> \$10,000 is out of question for us to pay this. We represent a lot of students and we haven't put on an event from the SU with as much money as that besides fresh fest.
- <u>Ankit</u> Considering that they want an amount of monkey that we do not have, I think it would just make sense to table this motion.
- Yewoe tabling this motion is not really a good idea because they did say that they budgeted in the case that we don't give them any funds. If we table it, it would be too close to their event.
- <u>Raven</u> I've been looking at their application and there are a few discrepancies. The budget that they have listed is \$12,000. Is the budget 12 grand or 22 grand? I'm trying to remember last year's event, not sure if they were selling tickets for this event.
- <u>Mason</u> perhaps we should only give them 7500.
- <u>Cheri</u> perhaps we could help them find alternative funding, or slashing of their budget.
- <u>Maleeka</u> I'm open to meeting with them to discuss other options. I met with them and Martha to discuss a Black History Month showcase.
