## **General Assembly Meeting**

May 5th saw the inaugural meeting of the 2017/2018 General Assembly. As is typical for our May meeting, we did have some difficulty attaining quorum but were able to move forward thanks to some members being able to join electronically.

### **CAUS Transition (Canmore, AB)**

May 13th-16th saw VP External Conner Peta, myself, and our predecessors (Cameron Howey and Cody Ciona) attend CAUS' annual transition in Canmore, AB. The purpose of this conference is to familiarize new CAUS delegates with the advocacy work of their predecessors, and prepare them to carry new and existing initiatives forward. #### **SACPA Moderation**

I had the honor of being asked to moderate a session by Dr. Mike Mahon, University of Lethbridge President, hosted by the Southern Alberta Council of Public Affairs. This talk centered around the 50th anniversary of the University of Lethbridge; the progress that has been made by the institution and what the next 50 years might look like. It was a great opportunity to see how non-student community members engaged with the presentation and asked meaningful questions to Dr. Mahon.

### **CASA Foundations Conference (Ottawa, ON)**

May 22nd to 26th, VP External Conner Peta and I attended the Canadian Alliance of Student Associations' Foundations Conference in Ottawa, ON/Gatineau, QC. This is the first of four meetings with CASA, and it was very well received by our ULSU delegates. A full conference report on CASA Foundations 2017 will be made available online.

#### **UPass Referendum**

Along with my VP External, Conner Peta, and VP Operations & Finance, Royal Adkin, I have begun to investigate the potential for a third UPass referendum to be put forward to the student body by the ULSU. A few months ago, City Council approved a potential UPass at \$77/semester with an additional opt-out clause to include students who reside within a 1.25km radius of the institution. As an executive, we believe that the implementation of a UPass plan will greatly reduce the strain on University Parking Services and allow greater mobility to students within the City of Lethbridge. We are very interested in going forward with a referendum in February of 2018, for potential UPass implementation in September 2018.
