#### CAUS Counterpart Meeting

From November 5<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> we were able to visit our CAUS counterparts in Edmonton for our second counterpart meeting. This meeting was particularly beneficial for me because I was able to make time with the other Vice-President Academics in order to start planning the #TextbookBrokeAB campaign that all five CAUS schools will be hosting come this January.

This meeting consisted of a round table with all executives, for which we addressed issues such as international student tuition, reconciliation, and many other topics. As alluded to earlier I was also able to meet with all of the other VP Academics to plan events, and build off of each other's ideas. It was really productive, and we planned the #TextbookbrokeAB campaign. We also had a presentation from Shane Scott, the VP Academic about diversity in university student union elections.

While in Edmonton, we also had the opportunity to attend Question Period at the Alberta Legislature, and were introduced by Dr. Swan, the Member of the Legislative assembly of Alberta for Calgary-Mountain View, and member of the Liberal party.

#### Mental Health Week

Mental Health Week this semester took place from November 20th to 24th. The most notable aspect of the week were the "Calm Cafés" that we ran in conjunction with the Student Success Center from the Tuesday to Thursday. We continued to host "Calm Cafes" until Friday however, for the last day we collaborated with the Smash Bros Club. ### #TextbookbrokeAB Planning

The intention of the campaign will be to create awareness around around on-the-rise textbook prices, as well as to promote Open Education Resources as alternatives to the traditional practice. I have been slowly planning this campaign and I hope to have everything ready to go for January very soon.
