Board of Governors

General Faculties Committee

As mentioned in my previous report, a "committee of the whole" was formed consisting of all of GFC and carrying the same powers as the Independent Consulting Committee, in order to review the reports made by the Budgetary Taskforces and to make recommendations to the Budget Advisory Committee. Starting in March, the CotW will start to have regular meetings.

GoA Student Leaders Meeting & Meeting with Minister Nicolaides

We had our second-last meeting with many of the other student leaders from across Alberta and across sectors this month. Minister Nicolaides presented some options regarding tuition recommendations withing Alberta2030, as well as garnered conversation and feedback on what AB2030 may be giving as its final recommendations in the coming months.

I had a brief meeting with the Minister the following week where I advocated for limits and ties to CPI to be added back to tuition, as well as the preservation of autonomy when it comes to the governance of the post-secondary institutions.

HR Meetings

A responsibility that the President shares with the VP Operations and Finance, as well as the General Manager, is overseeing the Human Resources of the ULSU. There were several meetings this month revolving around various sensitive issues.
