- Introduction Meeting with Accommodated Learning Centre (ALC) May 5, 2022
   I have met with Dawn Vickers (ALC Manager) about the services that the ALC provides our students. This was a meeting that the entire EC attended but was most relevant to the Academic portfolio.
- <u>ULSU Executive Council Meetings May 18, 2022, & May 25, 2022</u> The EC has met twice in the month of May. So far the EC has dealt with general administrative functions such as approving Travel Grants and Emergency Grants.
- Meeting with Kathleen Massey & Natasha Buis Deering May 16, 2022
   I met with Kathleen Massey, Associate VP (Students) and Natasha Buis Deering, University Registrar in regard to centralizing student services, supports, and resources onto one single hub/portal. This is my big project for the year. I hope to have a working prototype of the hub/portal by Spring 2023.

   The Alberta Ministry of Advanced Education announced a sizable grant to allow
   Southern Alberta post-secondairy institutions to increase the number of seats
   offered in select programs. This will help the University of Lethbridge increase our
   metrics in terms of Work Integrated Learning.
- Mental Health Programming Meeting with Michaela May 18, 2022
   I have met with Michaela Crump to discuss the Mental Health events and programs that the ULSU host this Academic Year.
- <u>Agility Innovation Zone Introduction Meeting May 18, 2022</u>
   On May 18th I met with Dave Hinger and Rob Horlacher at the Agility Innovation
   Zone to discuss the Teaching Centre and Agility. The purpose of this meeting is to find
   ways the work together to promote both the Students' Union & Agility this Fall.

   Internationalization Strategy May 20, 2022
   On May 20th I met with Erasmus Okine (Provost & VP Academic) and Michelle
