#### **Hours Breakdown**

November 1, 2021 – I attended General Faculties Council where the discussion was focused primarily around updates to the curriculum and faculty restructuring. These changes will take effect May 1, 2022 and include changes to registration, seat limits, available minors, and course requirements for programs. We also talked in great length about faculty restructuring, which I'll mention more in my A&S Council blurb below. (1.5 hours)

November 1, 2021 – I attended our General Assembly bonding event at Roundtable! We played some awesome board games and got to know one another better, so I consider it to have been a very productive night! (1.5 hours)

November 3, 2021 – I volunteered for fellow A&S Rep Madina's Townhall event! We sat in the Science Commons Atrium and talked with some students passing by and also handed out some free swag. I was able to explain what the ULSU is, what resources we offer, and hopefully I convinced a few people to follow our Instagram, which is @ulethsu if you're interested in following us! (2 hours)

November 16, 2021 – I chaired the A&S Executive Committee meeting where we set the agenda for this month's council meeting and also spoke about faculty restricting (because this topic has invaded every aspect of my being). We ended up deciding to attach reports to council to the agenda package rather than share them in meeting as we knew it was going to be a long one (see A&S Council below). (1 hour)

November 22, 2021 – I filled out the Executive Accountability Survey and am now waiting to get all of them completed so that the Executive Accountability Committee members and I can share the feedback we received! (1 hour)

November 24, 2021 – Okay folks, we've arrived to A&S Council which was a bit of a nightmare. We received a presentation regarding faculty restricting which is essentially the idea that the number of faculties will be consolidated in order to save money. The comments during this presentation were spicy, and it appears that other on-campus organizations such as ULFA and the GSA share a similar sentiment as to what the ULSU does. As a student in the faculty, I asked how one could state students won't be greatly affected considering removing many associate deans is removing several important resources for students as they provide aid with grade appeals, problems with faculty, and more. The answer I was given was that these tasks could be delegated to other individuals such as department chairs, but I have yet to see where students were consulted during the restructuring process. (2 hours)

November 26, 2021 – During A&S Council, Dean Matt Letts invited the ULSU A&S Reps to come meet with himself and the faculty's associate deans, so I crafted an email and worked on some correspondence to make this meeting happen! (1 hour)

November 29, 2021 – I met with ULSU President Holly to chat about some of my thoughts about faculty restricting so that I might be able to get some answers to my questions and so that we could chat about what this would realistically look like for students. (1 hour)
