- As both a rep from the ULSU and CAUS chair, I have been following the dramatic changes
  in Alberta politics closely as they have the capacity to significantly affect the advocacy we
  do. Notably:
  - o The UCP announced the new Premiere of Alberta on Oct 6 (Danielle Smith)
  - Danielle Smith announced her Cabinet shuffle on Oct 21. Some notable announcements include:
    - Demetrios Nicolaides continues as Minister of Advanced Ed
    - Nathan Neudorf (Lethbridge East) is a Deputy Premier and the Minister of Infrastructure
  - The UCP AGM happened on the weekend of Oct 22. Similarly, the NDP had their convention on the weekend of Oct 22.
- This month, Wasiimah Joomun, the CASA Member Relations Staff member, came to visit the ULSU and speak about CASA, the advocacy we do, and answer questions from our General Assembly. It was such a great opportunity to have a great discussion with our whole GA about how we can better represent ULeth students on a federal level!
- ASEC (Alberta Students' Executive Council) is a very similar student advocacy organization to CAUS, representing just over 100,000 Post Secondary Students across the province (they represent College and Polytechnics, whereas CAUS supports University undergraduates). This month, ASEC announced they made the unfortunate decision to dissolve their Board. While they sort out the details of their by-election and what the rest



of their year might look like, it has left CAUS in an interesting position on how we can

continue supporting and advocating for students outside of our organization while

maintaining our autonomy. We look forward to finding ways to work together and

represent students across the province, especially within our GOTV campaign.

This month we had our ULSU Garage Sale where we sold items donated from Housing

Services, all proceeds going to our foodbank. While we don't have final figures at the time

of me writing this report, it was an extremely wholesome event where people (students,

faculty, and staff alike) were able to purchase items they needed while contributing to a

great cause at the same time. It was overall a great success!

• This month, the Students' Union hosted a Diwali Party! It was so much fun with lots of

good food and even better dancing. It was such an honour to be included in such an

important cultural tradition for so many members of our campus, and I am looking forward

to similar events that will be held in the future.

This month, Public Interest Alberta hosted their Better Way Alberta Tour, which featured

stops across the province to speak about what individuals envision for a better province

moving forward. At their Lethbridge stop, I gave a speech on behalf of both the ULSU and

CAUS on what a better future for Post Secondary Education. It was a great chance to

participate in student advocacy in front of a different crowd and to represent students in

front of very different, yet equally important stakeholders.
